Dear Counselor,

Are your students looking for a great education at an affordable price that will lead to an exciting career with endless employment opportunities? One of Ohio's best nursing programs is located here in our area! Trinity School of Nursing is a two year RN diploma nursing education program. It has been educating area nurses for 109 years. Pre-admission requirements for Trinity School of Nursing include completion of high school algebra I and high school chemistry I with a grade of C or above, GPA of 2.75 or higher, and a recommended ACT score of 21 or SAT score of 1070. Students will also have to pass the TEAS entrance test given on our campus.

Students can enter our program right after high school. No pre-admission college courses are required. However, many recent high school graduates have struggled in our program. In order to best prepare students for success in our program, we recommend that only the exceptional high school student enter our program directly after high school. Average high school students would benefit from attending a year at a community college in order to refine their study skills and test taking abilities, and mature as a student. Additionally, attending a community college for a year affords the student the opportunity to complete all of the college courses that are part of our curriculum, thereby allowing them to transfer credit and lighten their course load once they enter our program. The college courses that are transferable include Anatomy and Physiology (I and II), Microbiology, General Psychology, Sociology, and Human Growth and Development.


Trinity School of Nursing is accredited by the Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing and approved by the Ohio Board of Nursing and the Ohio Board of Career Colleges and Schools (registration number 2192). Our RN Licensure Exam pass rates consistently exceed State and National rates. **Our 2020 NCLEX-RN Licensure Exam pass rate was 100%.**

Diploma RN graduates take the same licensure exam that is taken by RN graduates of associate degree and bachelor degree programs. They are also eligible for the same entry level jobs. Diploma RN graduates are able to easily continue their education to obtain a Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) or a Master of Science in Nursing (MSN), if desired.
