Three students from John Marshall will attend a meeting as a guest on March 12, 2025, and then return the following week on March 19, 2025, to make their presentation. One winner will be chosen from the three who present to the Rotary. The winner will receive \$1000.

The three senior class students will be selected by the counselor using the following criteria:

1. Grade point average of 3.0 or better
2. List all extracurricular activities (at least 6) they have been a participant of during their 4 years in high school.
3. List all school organizations in which they have been a participant and any offices held during their high school years
4. List all of their community volunteer service participation
5. Signature recommendations from 4 teachers (their counselor should be one)
6. Choose a topic of interest that they have a passion for; such as, a hobby, family, school, church, organizations, etc. The presentation they make should relate to the four-way test (enclosed). The presentation MUST be reviewed (and signed by an English or Speech teacher) before the presentation.

All three students will need to bring a picture, a short biography and a copy of their presentation for us to keep in our files.
